<b>Uniform Style</b> Pants Shorts, skirts Jumpers Dresses	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No jean or sweat material</li> <li>Must be long enough to reach the tips of students' fingers when their arms hang straight down</li> </ul>	Solid navy blue Khaki
<b>Uniform Style</b> Shirts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must have a collar</li> <li>Polo or button-up</li> </ul> <p>Turtleneck shirts are not uniform shirts and can only be worn under a uniform shirt.</p>	White Navy blue Light blue Gray Burgundy
Socks and leggings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Solid colors ONLY (black socks/ leggings are okay)</li> </ul>	White Navy blue Khaki Gray Burgundy
Sweaters and jackets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Jackets and sweaters worn <b>inside the classroom</b> MUST be solid uniform colors</li> <li>Jackets and sweaters worn <b>outdoors</b>-any style/color.</li> </ul>	White Navy blue Gray Burgundy
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Closed toe – no exceptions</li> <li>Sandals must have back strap</li> <li>½ inch maximum heel</li> </ul>	
Individualized hair accessories are allowed.		

## College T-Shirt Fridays!

On Fridays, students may wear blue solid denim pants, shorts or skirts IF they are wearing a shirt with a college/university logo, or a shirt with the ROCS logo. **Fridays ARE NOT free dress days!** Uniform shirts and sports jerseys DO NOT qualify students to wear denim bottoms.
